## Using Dan's Beckman Scintillation Counter (Urey Hall 6<sup>th</sup> Floor):

- 1. Take out all the racks from the scintillation counter. Make sure there is paper in the attached printer.
- 2. Place an EMPTY VIAL in Rack# 1 at position 10 for <sup>32</sup>P or at position 12 for <sup>35</sup>S. This tells the machine the counting mode.
- 3. Place SAMPLE VIALS in Rack#2 (positions 1 to 12; use more racks if you have more than 12 samples).
- 4. Place an empty Rack after the sample rack(s). This tells the machine to STOP counting.
- 5. After all the racks are placed into right half of the instrument, close the lid.
- 6. Follow the instructions on the LCD screen (press SELECT then press START to begin counting).
